Starting Point

Begin with the title.

about. Try to engage the
reader's interest right
from the start.

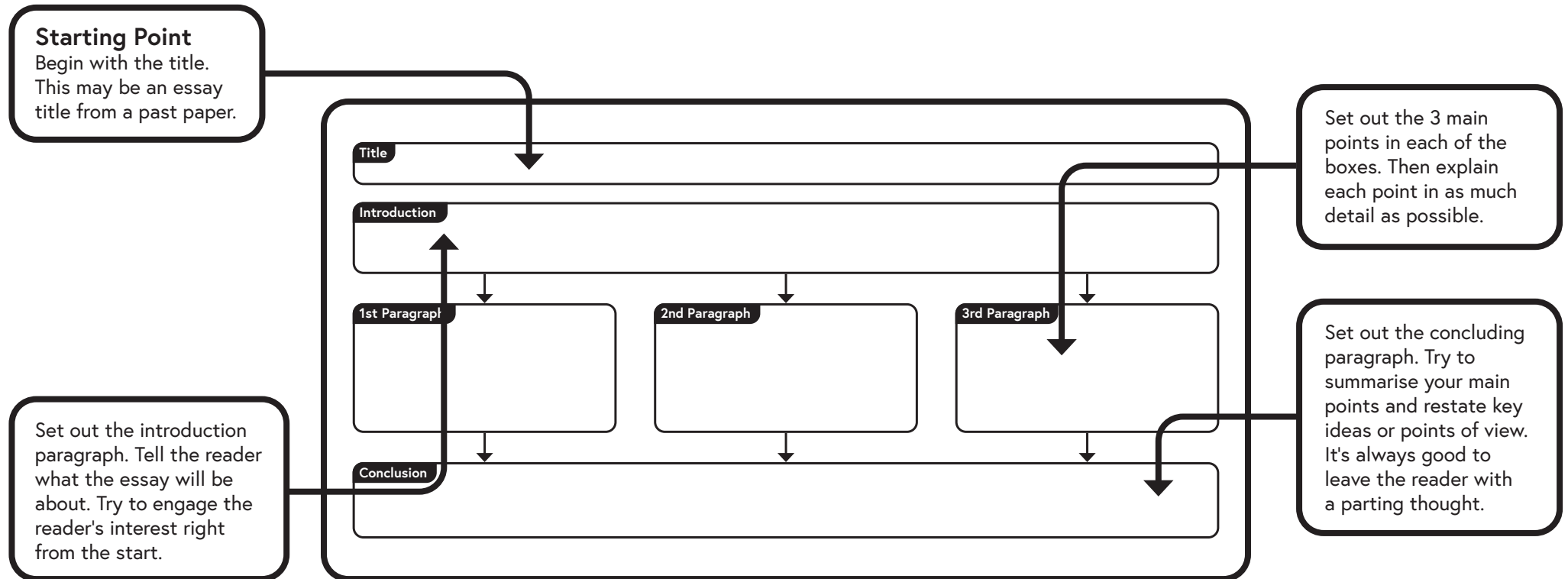
